

GROUND RULES

CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents and fans

- Support by positive cheering
- Do not coach from the sidelines or stands
- Avoid public disagreement with coaching or refereeing
- Disparaging remarks toward other teams, their coaches or fans is unacceptable
- Post-game activities 'hanging out' (representatives of EVAC)
- Social media posts should be positive, celebrations and recognition

Coaches and athletes

- Must graciously accept all calls by referees
- Process to protest unfair play by opponents (contact athletic director)
- Maintain an attitude of humility on and off the courts and fields
- All that is said and done For His Glory



Coaches and athletes and parents

- CAA focused on sportsmanship this year
- Treat the referees with respect
- Ejection from a game = 1 game suspension
- Must complete NFHS Sportsmanship online course certificate to return
- 2nd ejection = suspension remainder of season
- No appeals

EVAC focused on our code of conduct, emphasis on bad language

- Meeting with coach, parents, sport coordinator, AD
- Warning 1 game suspension Board review, possible season suspension

CODE OF CONDUCT

We want to inform you of an important update regarding spectator behavior at our home basketball and volleyball games. Moving forward, spectators will no longer be permitted to step foot on the court pre-game or during the game. The court is strictly reserved for athletes, coaches, referees, EVAC Cheer team, and other necessary volunteers during these times. After the game, spectators may come onto the court to socialize but are not allowed to bring or use any balls in the gym.

FEES AND LOGISTICS



Fees and direct expenses

- CAA league fees
- Gym and field rentals
- Operational overhead
- Insurance
- TOURNAMENTS NOT INCLUDED

ESA — EVAC is not a vendor, Current policy to not provide Attestation Form for reimbursement. Seek advice from other ESA families on reimbursement.

PAY BY DEC 30TY Income and donations

- Fees paid through App/Link
- Welcome tax-deductible donations
- Examples: team specific, travel costs, warm-ups, scholarships, and equipment
- Fund raising events
- Donate on website



Jersey or full uniform — athlete owned

- Name (HS only) and number
- Reversable or Separates (home/away)
- Options to purchase other uniform items at the same time or on your own
- Player will keep your owned uniform throughout junior high OR high school years.
- Care and maintenance is <u>your</u> responsibility.
- Can purchase duplicates or new sizes for later years.
- EVAC has moved to this model for all teams moving forward this year.
